

Residence and work visa for others (TET, TRA)

- This visa allows the applicant (who is over 16 years old) to obtain a temporary residence visa in Spain (for a period of more than 90 days), and also allows him to carry out a profitable or professional activity for the other's benefits. The applicant shall submit himself within a maximum of one month from the date the employer informs him of obtaining a residence and work permit issued by the competent government representation, or the competent regional authority.

Important Alert:

After entering Spain legally and within three months, the applicant must be registered and participate in the social insurance system that will apply to him, in order to pay his dues. Participation in the social insurance system will contribute positively to obtaining the initial permit for temporary residence and work for the benefit of others.

Important statement about the identity card for foreigners:

Within one month after signing up for social insurance, the applicant must submit an application for a foreigner's identity card at the immigration office or local police.

Time required to respond:

The visa application will be answered after a month or more from the date of submission of the application, according to the procedures of the embassy.

Conditions and required documents:

The visa applicant must submit the following:

1. Visa application form.
2. A recent passport-sized photograph affixed to the application form, in colour and with a white background.
3. A passport or travel document recognized in Spain, valid for at least 4 months (although it would be preferable for a longer period of validity, for example a year). A photocopy of the first two pages of the passport must be attached. In case of extending the validity of the visa, a copy of the renewal page shall be provided. The passport or travel document must have been issued a maximum of 10 years prior to the date of travel. Renewed passports or travel documents that were first issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted. The passport must contain two blank pages.
4. A copy of the contract according to which the initial residence and work permit was granted for the benefit of others, stamped by the Foreigners' Office. This document must be sent from the employer to the visa applicant.
5. A copy of the "Residence and Work Permit Granting Decision" issued by the relevant government representation, registered and including the Número de Enlace de Visado (NEV) Visa Link Number. The data of the box for the notification date, signature, and ID card number must be filled out. This document must be sent from the employer to the

applicant.

6. A health certificate to prove that the applicant does not suffer from any diseases that have adverse effects on public health, in accordance with the International Health Regulations of 2005, and that this certificate is authenticated by the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Spain. (Original and photocopy).
7. Criminal records certificate - if the applicant is over 16 years old - issued by the authorities of the country or countries in which he resided during the past five years, and that no prison sentences have been issued against him in Spain. This certificate must be authenticated by the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Spain. (Original and photocopy).
