Non-Profit Temporary Resident (RES)

• The bearer is granted temporary residence in Spain without allowing him to engage in any professional activities.

Important statement about the identity card for foreigners:

After entering Spanish territory, the application for a foreigner's identity card must be submitted in person within one month at the Immigration Office or its police station. This card will be issued for the period for which the temporary residence permit is granted.

Time required to respond:

The visa application will be answered after a month or more from the date of submission of the application, according to the procedures of the embassy.

Conditions and required documents:

The visa applicant must submit the following:

- 1. Visa application form.
- 2. A recent photo, not older than 6 months, with a white background (3.5x4.5). <u>Image details.</u>
- 3. A passport or travel document recognized in Spain, valid for a period of not less than one year. A photocopy of the first two pages of the passport must be attached. If the validity of the passport has been extended, attach a copy of the renewal page. The passport or travel document must have been issued at most 10 years prior to the scheduled date of the trip. Renewed passports or travel documents that were first issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted. The passport must contain two blank pages.
- 4. Documents proving the availability of means of subsistence for the same person or evidence of his income at the rate of **2,400** euros per month for the visa applicant, **600** euros per month for each dependent family member during their stay in Spain (original).
- 5. The data of the EX01 application form (original) must be completed.
- 6. The data of the **790-52** application form (original) must be completed. (The Applicant must Deposit **12** \$ for the fees of **790-52** Form in the CIB Bank account of the **EMBASSY OF SPAIN**).
- 7. A health certificate stating that the applicant does not have diseases that could seriously affect public health, in accordance with the International Health Regulations of 2005, authenticated by the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Spain (original and photocopy).
- 8. A criminal record certificate- if the applicant is more than 16 years old issued by the Egyptian authorities or the authorities of the state or countries in which he resided during the past five years, and that no prison sentences have been issued against him in Spain. This certificate must be authenticated by the **Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and**

	the Embassy of Spain (original). If the visa applicant has resided in another country, he must authenticate this certificate from the Spanish embassy in this country.
9.	A Medical insurance policy, whether from a public or private entity, issued by an insurance entity accredited to work in Spain (original).
